We would like to thank you for awarding us the 2010 Grant in the amount of \$50,000! The purchases and opportunity for advancement in our medical practice made possible through the use of this money have greatly benefited our patients and the people of our community as a whole. Below you will find an outline of the results and financial information of these purchases, our future plans and photographs. Again, many thanks for your generosity.

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A lot of the discrepancy in prices is due to RMFP entering into a contract with Henry Schein Medical Supply Company to exclusively buy all medical supplies and equipment from them and thereby allowing us to take advantage of steep pricing discounts. As a result of the money we were able to save, we were able to purchase a Fetal Monitor at \$2931.77 which will be a huge complement to our existing Obstetrical patients and the ultrasound services we are currently able to offer.

We have made tremendous strides in achieving the stated goals and objectives related to this grant. The children of Lake County are now able to have a hearing and vision screen as part of a standard well child check appointment and no longer have to travel to another county to have these valuable screening procedures done.

Our patients now are able to benefit from having a cardiac stress test done right here in the office at the exact altitude at which they live, affording us a valuable diagnostic opportunity. We have in fact had 2 positive stress tests for cardiac events thus far. We were able to quickly diagnose these patients and refer them on to a specialist for immediate evaluation which may otherwise have led to a poor outcome. The vaccine refrigerator has allowed us to become compliant with VFC recommendations and we are able to carry a wider array of vaccines for all people of the community due to our increased storage space. The technology aspect of our purchases has made a positive impact for both the staff at RMFP and our patients. We are now able to be much more efficient and timely within the clinic with the new desktops, server and fax server and are able to perform patient services such as filling prescriptions, faxing medical records and information and general patient care much more quickly with quality equipment to greater patient satisfaction levels.

We are pleased to report that as of April 1 2011, we have extended our hours and services to become a full service Urgent Care center as well as continuation of all of the current Family Practice services RMFP has always offered. We noticed an immediate response from the community and have gotten a large amount of positive feedback that our extended hours and increased amount of services offered have been a real asset to Lake County. It is a direct result of our new technology and equipment purchased with this grant that we have been able to extend our services.

Our future plans include incorporating radiology equipment into the practice for on-site diagnostic use and continuing our Children's and Adult Health Fair each September. We've included a few pictures of our Health Fair as well as some photos of our new equipment.
